

Join us for three wild rides in the Adelaide Hills!

We'd love you to join us, Phil Liggett MBE, (widely known as the Voice of Cycling), Hon. Australian of the Year (2018), Hon. Doctorate of University of South Australia (2019) and Trish Liggett OLY and Founder of Freedom To Roam Adventures in our new Australian fundraising venture based in the Adelaide Hills, South Australia in 2024 at either Monarto Safari Park or Koala Life, Cleland Wildlife Park.

We have chosen Monarto Safari Park, specifically to assist in safeguarding the highly endangered, and totally unique, rhinoceros from extinction.

Monarto Safari Park's work in rhino conservation spans across the globe: working with The Australian Rhino Project, the park aims to relocate endangered Southern White Rhinoceros to Australia in an effort to safeguard the species while the poaching crisis in Africa is brought under control.

Koala Life, based at Cleland Wildlife Park, is our second target. Their ground-breaking research and development work is now establishing a disease-free population of this uniquely Australian, adorable and iconic marsupial.



These two events – both two nights and three days, will 'top and tail' the famous international UCI world ranking cycle race, the Santos Tour Down Under.

The first event will be based within the grounds of Monarto Safari Park. You will stay at the new safari resort within the park's new Wild Africa precinct. The accommodation has stunning views over waterholes and the Monarto plains.

The wild is calling!

Monarto Safari Park is some 70 kms from Adelaide, and has been transformed over the past few years. It is the largest safari experience to exist outside of Africa. Spanning more than 1,500 hectares and home to more than 50 species of exotic and native mammals, birds and reptiles, you can fit every major zoo in Australia inside the Park and still have land left over! Monarto Safari Park is home to many of Africa's most impressive animals and also one of Australia's largest lion prides and giraffe herds. Large open-range exhibits allow visitors to see amazing animals in a natural setting.

A precious few highly endangered Southern White and Black Rhinoceros are already living at Monarto Safari Park. But sadly, both species are still under huge threat from poaching in Africa. Monarto Safari Park is working with The Australian Rhino Project (TARP), to bring a number of rhino from Africa to Australia to safeguard the species. Caring for a large number of rhinos is a very expensive exercise and is one of the key areas to which funds raised will go.

Event 2Koala Life

The second event will be based at the beautiful Mount Lofty Hotel in the Adelaide Hills, just a few kilometres from Cleland Wildlife Park, the home of disease-free Koala and their young, the female, breeding age koalas, rescued from Kangaroo Island in the devastating fires of 2019/20. Young, and many with burn injuries are now thriving, and ready to form the base of the next generation.

Supporting science to save an Australian icon

Koala Life is based within Cleland Wildlife Park, just a few kilometres from Adelaide. The devastating fires of 2019/20 stimulated radical action by Koala Life. An ambitious programme has been launched that will change the balance of the koala population in Australia.

Koalas on the mainland, suffer from two hereditary diseases that are present in the majority of the population. A small number of rescued females from Kangaroo Island, along with a few male koalas from the Strzelecki Ranges in Victoria, will breed at Cleland Wildlife Park. These disease-free koalas and their young will be kept completely separate from the mainland inhabitants, to ensure a healthy future for this well-loved unique animal. This is ground breaking work, and is the focus of our fundraising.

Arrive at Monarto Safari Park to check in to the newly opened Wild Africa Safari Resort or private glamping accommodation with stunning views over waterholes and the Monarto plains.

Day 1

- Experience 1. Discover Monarto Safari Park on a private guided tour and see some of the incredible species that call Wild Africa home such as zebra, antelope and giraffe.
- Experience 2. As the day comes to and end you will take the walk of the brave during Lions 360, Monarto Safari Park's 360 degree lion experience and enjoy "Sundowner" drinks within clawing range of one of Australia's largest lion prides.
- Experience 3. Our expert guides will then transport us to the outdoor deck to dine and marvel at the park's magnificent giraffes and antelope.

Day 2

- Experience 1. After an early morning breakfast you will get to leap into the Land of the Lemurs and meet Monarto Safari Park's Ringtailed Lemurs troop as well as encounter the Tortoise Research Facility where Vulnerable Aldabra giant tortoises and Critically Endangered Radiated Tortoises lap up life in the slow lane.
- Experience 2. We move from the open plains to the open rides as you join Phil and other well-known cyclists on a one way ride from Monarto to Langhorne Creek. There you will get to enjoy an afternoon of wine tasting at Kimbolton Wines, one of South Australia's premium wineries and supporter of Monarto Safari Park's conservation projects. Kimbolton Wines are one of six wineries partnering with the park as part of Grapes for Good proof that wine can be a force for good, with part proceeds from the sale of these wines supporting Zoos SA's conservation mission.
- Experience 3. Upon your return, you will enjoy some free time in your luxury accommodation before joining us in the private dining room at the Lodge for "Sundowners and Dinner". Senior staff from Zoos South Australia will be joining us for this dinner to continue the conversation.



Day 3

- Experience 1. Start the final day with a guided, behind the scenes bush walk to learn more about the rejuvenation of the land and operations of the park. You will get to experience the magnificent native plant life and wildflowers of Monarto Safari Park and delight in the native wildlife and birds that call it home.
- Experience 2 Enjoy your breakfast before joining us for our second ride through the stunning Adelaide Hills. Arrive at the award winning Ambleside Distillery, who partner with Zoos SA to save the endangered rhino. Enjoy a variety of gins including Kifaru Gin, specifically created using botanicals grown on site at Monarto Safari Park with proceeds supporting the white rhino.

After a leisurely lunch, we will return to Adelaide where the pre Santos Tour Down Under events take place in the streets of Adelaide in the form of two criteriums - first the womens' event followed by the mens' event. Guests will be invited to enjoy both events and the hospitality offered.



Arrive to Mt Lofty House to check in to the to this historic property for a magnificent 3 days in the Adelaide Hills.

Day 1

- Experience 1. Join the VIP list as you enjoy the corporate hospitality of the Santos Tour Down Under for the afternoon on the final stage of the race.
- Experience 2. Enjoy "Sundowners" with the team at the Old Coach house
- Experience 3. A sumptuous buffet will be shared for "Movie Night" with Phil and Friends; Q&A with Phil Liggett and enjoy a relaxed Movie Night enjoying "The Voice of Cycling".

Day 2

- Experience 1. Breakfast is not to be missed at Martha Hardy's Kitchen enjoying the breath-taking valley views.
- Experience 2. Join a morning walk with local guides and Trish Liggett, or a morning ride to explore the Adelaide Hills with Phil Liggett ride the route of the "pros-cycling riders" and test your skills (we promise its only a section!)
- Experience 3. At the conclusion of the morning activities, we will return to Mt Lofty House and then transfer to Cleland Wildlife Park to meet the Koalas. A behind the scenes afternoon to learn about the work of Koala Life to protect the future of one of Australia's national treasures. Each person will get to hold one of Cleland's celebrated Koalas with a personal photo.
- Experience 4. As the park closes, the tour will stay behind to enjoy a private "Sundowner Drinks and Dinner" amongst the natural environment of so many animals on site with a magnificent view of Adelaide. The tour will return to Mt Lofty House and enjoy a nightcap in one of the many private Bar & Tasting rooms to wrap up an extraordinary day.

Day 3

- Experience 1. Grab a coffee to start the day as we head to Cleland Wildlife Park to enjoy Breakfast with the Birds! With the park still not open to the public we will enjoy a private tour with the Rangers to learn more about the animals' habitats and the impact we all make on them.
- Experience 2 The tour will transfer back to Mt Lofty House to enjoy the historic property with a late check out. You may choose to stay on in the Adelaide Hills for the day or the tour will return to Adelaide around lunch time.
